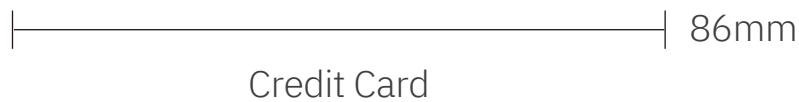




Ring Size Guide

Before using one of the methods listed below to find your fit, ensure this guide is printed on A4 paper (210mm × 297mm) at 100% scale. To verify the accuracy of your printout, place a credit card on the line below. The scale is correct if the length of the credit card matches the line.



Find Your Perfect Fit

Notice: The best way to get your perfect ring size is by measuring the inner diameter of the ring. There are too many factors that affect the measurement of the circumference. You can take the option 1 measurement method as a reference.

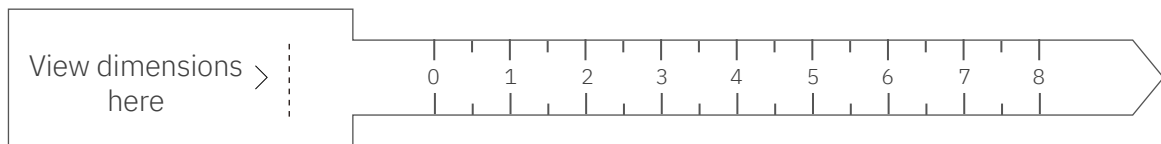
Option 1

1. A ring you already own that perfectly fits the finger on which you will wear your DR ring.
2. Print our chart of ring size circles.
3. Place the ring on top of each circle, ensuring the inner part is measured, until you find one that perfectly matches.

Option 2

1. Print and carefully cut out the paper ring sizer below.
2. Use a ruler to measure the lines to ensure they are accurate.
3. Wrap the sizer snugly around your finger through the slot and check the marked size.



Option 3

1. Cut a small piece of string, thread, or ribbon from a spool.
2. Wrap it snugly around your finger for an accurate measurement.
3. Lay the string flat and use a ruler to measure its length up to the mark. Use the chart to match this measurement to the closest DR ring size.
